1. Jesus wants you to come to him. You don't have to wait until you're older to follow Jesus. You can trust in Jesus right now. Jesus came to save you from your sin and to give you eternal life.
2. If you come to Jesus, he will welcome you with open arms. Jesus is kind and merciful. Jesus will never send you away; he's never too busy for you.
3. You can spend time with Jesus by listening to the Bible. Jesus speaks to us through the Bible. He tells us about God, and the kingdom of heaven, and how to live a life that's pleasing to him.
4. You can spend time with Jesus in prayer. Tell Jesus about your troubles. Ask him to help you. Worship and praise him. Thank him for all the good things he's done.
