JAMIE MOON

Jamie serves with InterVarsity at UW-Stevens Point. She became engaged with the gospel through InterVarsity and became a quiet but bold leader in the ministry her last two

years of college. She followed God's leading to love and care for international students in particular, and developed an outreach event called *Tea & Talk* to intentionally serve and minister to them. As she began to realize how significantly IV had impacted her life, she felt called to return to campus and work full-time with them.

Right now Jamie is able to work about 20 hours each week with IV. The remainder of her week is working on building her support team. She is 84% funded right now, so keep on praying! When she's not doing IV work, she has spent most of her time settling in. That has meant spending time getting reacquainted with the Stevens Point community, and making deeper connections in her local church.

Here are some prayer points:

- Praise God for all He has done through the ministry of students to their peers on campus this semester!
- Pray for wisdom for Jamie and the team as they seek to care for and lead students well.
- Pray for students to sign up for their Winter Conference.
- This past semester 19 Chinese students have attended the IV Chinese Bible study, and about 8 come to study God's Word regularly! Pray that Jesus would become their salvation.
