Who is this helper? He is God the Holy Spirit. What does he do? He comes to live inside us and to help us live a life that is pleasing to God. Here are just a few of the ways the Spirit helps us:

- ☆ He causes us to be born again and gives us new spiritual life (John 3:5-6).
- ☆ He teaches us and helps us understand the Bible (John 14:26).
- \Rightarrow He helps us when we pray (Romans 8:26).

This verse reminds us that, as a Christian, you are <u>never</u> alone. God the Holy Spirit will <u>always</u> be with you. He will always watch over you and help you no matter what the situation.
