Imagine you have a special box with a never-ending supply of cookies! The box is never empty. You can eat as much as you’d like. Eat 10 cookies; 10 more appear in the box. Give 50 cookies to all your friends, 100 to all the kids at school... and still the box is full. Day after day, week after week, there are more cookies in the box. It never runs out. It’s filled with fresh cookies, every day, for your entire life.

God’s love is like that box of cookies. Verses 17-18 tell us the **“steadfast love of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting.”** That means it lasts forever; it’s never-ending, eternal, boundless, infinite. God’s love never runs out. He will love you today, tomorrow, next week... every day for your entire life.

The blessings of God’s love are **“on those who fear (honor) him”** and **“remember to do (obey) his commandments.”** Obeying God is a way of showing we love and honor him. God’s commandments are good. We should want to obey them. But what happens when we disobey? We must ask Jesus to forgive us and to help us follow God in obedience. Trusting in Jesus is what saves us, not our obedience. Yet, those who trust in Jesus will obey their heavenly Father more and more, just like Jesus obeyed the Father.
